1. Custodial Contract and Grounds Care Review and Recommendation- Commission discussed possible changes in scope to the custodial contract. One proposed option suggested was to close the Town Square pavilion restrooms during the winter if needed. Commission members recommend that the "Town and Country brand" service level needs to continue to look clean and safe. No changes were recommended to either contract. Anne Nixon proposed allocating all budgeted funds for seasonal park employee toward "time and materials" in the custodial contract instead. Professional, contracted cleaning contractors are more reliable and cost effective than seasonal staff. Commission members unanimously supported this change.
