1. Call to Order

Ms. Robson called the meeting to order at 12:15 PM and the roll, as noted above, was called. There was a quorum.

2. Approval of June 14, 2021 Minutes

Ms. Murdock moved for approval, seconded by Ms. Gerber. The Minutes were approved.

3. Update - E-Cycle and Shred-It Event

Ms. Kuepfert provided the commission with quotes for each event, \$325 for the E-cycle event and \$675 for the Shred-It event. She noted that the Conservation budget has \$600 for 2021, so unless sponsors were to contribute, both events are not able to happen due to budget constraints. Following discussion, Ms. Robson moved to hold the E-cycle event on August 28<sup>th</sup> at Town Square, seconded by Ms. Blake and approved.

4. Green Thumb Award Options

Ms. Kuepfert presented award options to the Commission ranging from \$24 to \$71. She noted that only one award was "outdoor safe" and able to be placed in a garden. The Commission would like certificates presented to the other nominees. Following discussion, Ms. Murdock moved to purchase one engraved brick at a cost of \$24 to present to the Green Thumb Award winner and create certificates to present to the other nominees, seconded by Ms. Blake and approved.

5. 3<sup>rd</sup> Quarter Priority – Deer Management

The Commission discussed past efforts relating to deer management. With the limited budget, the Commission would like to focus efforts this year on education surrounding deer

management. Ms. Kuepfert will reach out to the Missouri Department of Conservation to request a representative attend a future meeting and give a presentation on deer management and control.

6. Chairman Report

Ms. Robson stated that she would like to discuss showing the “Bag-It” movie later this year, which was originally supposed to be shown in 2020 but was pushed due to the COVID pandemic. Discussion will be placed on a future agenda.
