**A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN APPROVING THE NAME "WIRTH GROVE"
FOR THE GROVE OF TREES ON THE SOUTHEAST SECTION OF THE TOWN SQUARE**

WHEREAS, The City of Town & Country development on Clayton Road just East of Mason Road known as Town Square was purchased from the Wirth family; and

WHEREAS, the area around Clayton and Mason Roads, formerly known as Altheim, Missouri, has been a public place for community gatherings for over a century; and

WHEREAS, the Wirth family had previously lived on the property and operated a blacksmith shop and service station for more than one hundred years; and


WHEREAS, it is the desire of the City of Town & Country to document the history of the property and the Wirth family on the property itself for the public; and

WHEREAS, the development plan for the property preserves an original grove of trees in the Southeast section of the Town Square with a trail running through it.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF TOWN & COUNTRY, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the preserved section of trees in the Southeast corner of the Town Square as shown on the attached drawing be named "The Wirth Grove".

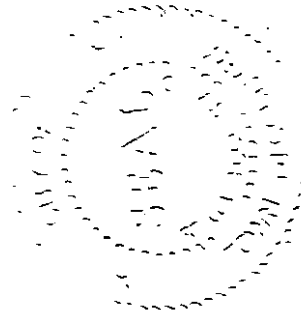


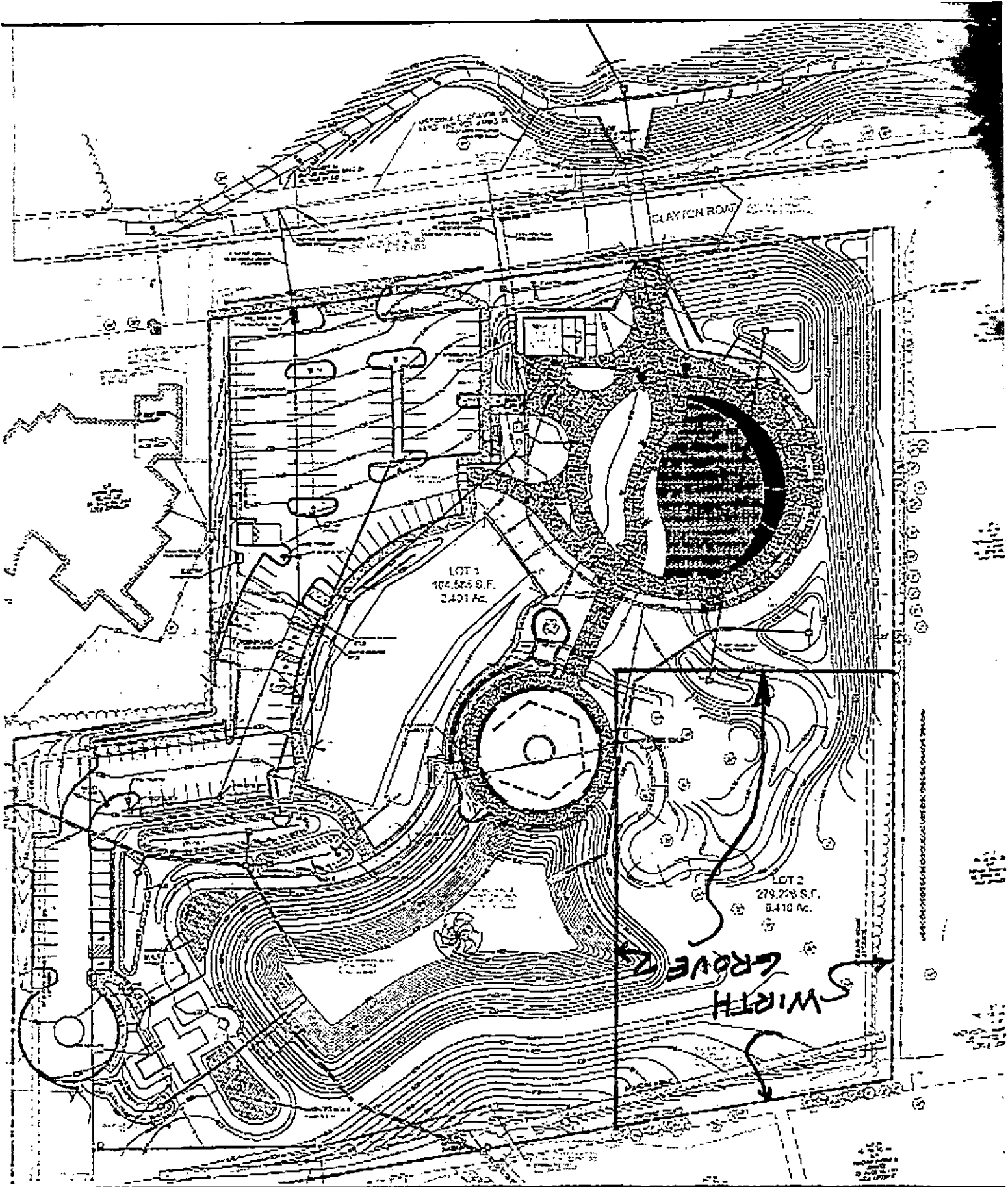
